Weekly Avocado Market Report

In North America, the U.S. market had greater sales activity in preparation for the Super Bowl on Feb. 2.

In Europe, Chilean supply was still present, although with a similar participation level to Spain and Israel. Sales were more active than in previous weeks.

Weekly Blueberry Market Report

In North America, the U.S. market had good activity and limited supply.

In Europe, moderate sales were seen with price adjustments.

In Asia, the Chinese market prepared for the biggest arrivals of the season to date.

Weekly Table Grape Market Report

In North America, the U.S. market was active with stable prices for white seedless grapes. Meanwhile, prices were recovering for Red Globes.

In Latin America, little movement was reported in Brazil.

In Europe, the market was still clear for white seedless grapes with firm prices for all varieties. In the U.K., low supply was accompanied by moderate sales. In Russia, slow sales continued for Red Globes.

In Asia, the market transitioned toward Peruvian supply.

Weekly Stone Fruit Market Report

In North America, supply was limited in the U.S. market and prices were still high.

In Latin America, sales were moderate in Brazil.

In Europe, there was a low supply of peaches and nectarines, while plums had more volumes. The Chilean season started during the week with the first peach sales.
